## Become a Volunteer

Becoming a volunteer with the Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks is a three-step process: contact your local community office, apply and undergo a background check, and receive authorization. Volunteers must submit an application and be authorized every year. The process is free for volunteers.

### Step 1: Contact Your Local Recreation Office

Call or email your [local recreation office](#), [recreation council](#), or [nature center](#), or the [Recreation Volunteer Coordinator](#) to find out what volunteer opportunities are available. You don't have to volunteer close to home, but your local office is the best place to start.

### Step 2: Submit Your Application Click here

Fill out the [online volunteer application](#). Your application provides the basis for your [background check](#).

The volunteer application is available on any device that connects to the internet, such as a smartphone, tablet, laptop or computer.
