- ❖ the applicant's participation in programs of the Parkville Recreation and Parks Council
- ❖ the applicant's financial need

The Scholarship Committee urges any high school senior planning to attend college, and who meets the criteria for this scholarship to apply as soon as possible. Every eligible applicant will be given the utmost consideration, and we wish each of you the best of luck in the pursuit of a higher education.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE 2016 PARKVILLE REC & PARKS COUNCIL, INC YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- 1.) All candidates for a scholarship must make a formal application for this aid to the scholarship committee postmarked by **April 14, 2018.**
 - 2.) All applicants must participate or have participated in programs of the Parkville Recreation & Parks Council.
 - 3.) The following qualities shall be used to determine the scholarship recipients:
 - a.) The academic performance of the applicant.
 - b.) The high school extra-curricular activity of the applicant.
 - c.) The applicant's community involvement.
 - d.) The applicant's financial need.
 - 4.) All funds shall be open for use in any accredited institution of higher learning. The student must take a course resulting in a degree and be a full time student (minimum 12 credit hours).
 - 5.) A draft on the scholarship fund will be awarded to the recipient directly in the amount designated by the scholarship committee and must be used in the following manner: (Check will be made payable to student & college)
 - a.) Dormitory room and board.
 - b.) Tuition and fees
 - c.) Books or educational materials.
- Satisfactory proof of the recipient's enrollment in college may be required. If the recipient does not enter college, the award shall be returned to the Scholarship Fund. Should the recipient withdraw before the completion of one semester's work, the amount expended for him/her and any remaining balance shall be repayable by the recipient to the Scholarship Fund. This shall not apply in cases of personal illness or extreme family emergencies which might necessitate their withdrawal from college. If the recipient should withdraw from school after a semester's work has been completed, any remaining funds shall be returned to the scholarship fund for use in future awards.
- 6.) This scholarship is available only to high school seniors, and if received must be used in the fall semester following their graduation from high school. A student may only receive this award once.
 - 7.) All decisions on scholarship selection by the scholarship committee shall be final.
 - 8.) This Youth Scholarship Fund is set up and governed by the Constitution and by Laws of the Parkville Recreation & Parks Council and the Youth Scholarship Fund.
